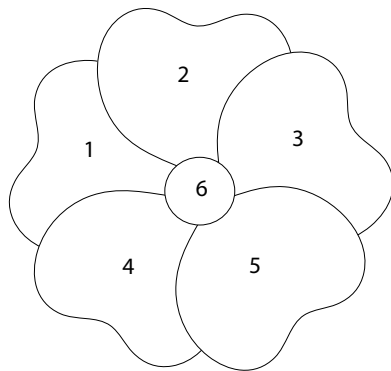


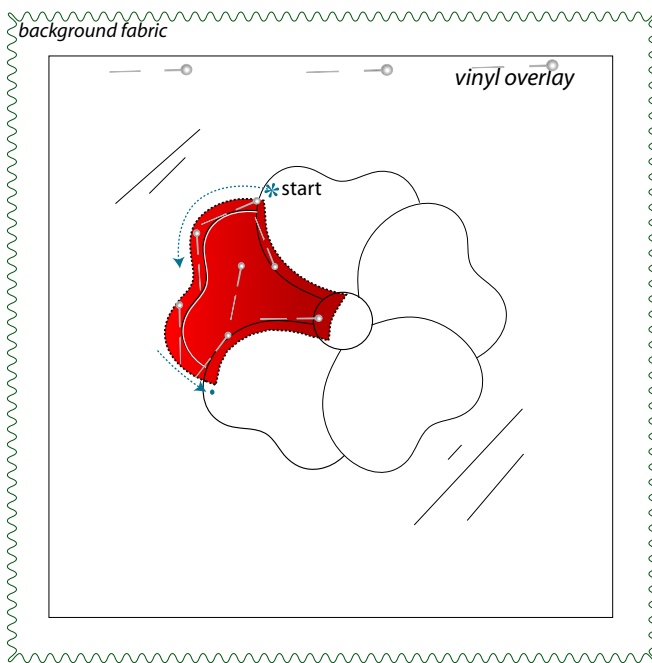
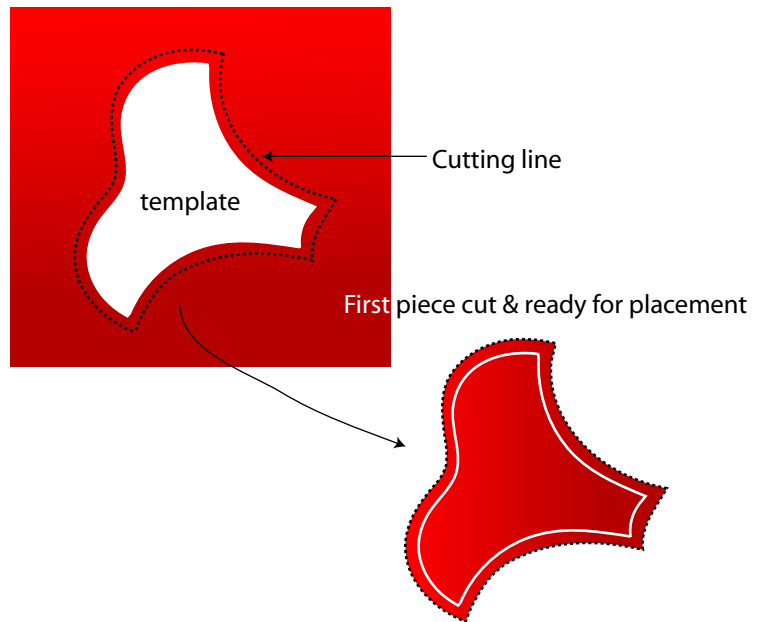
# Basic Layered Applique

Numbering Sequence:

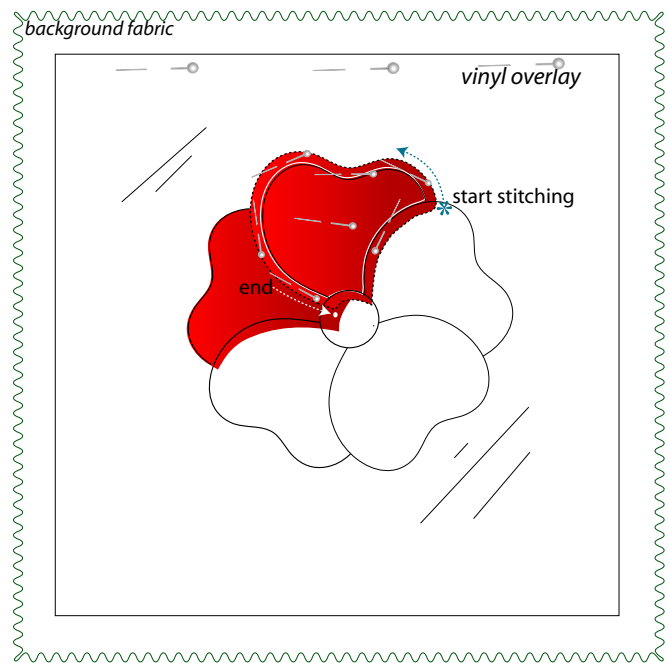


*Using a rose as an example*

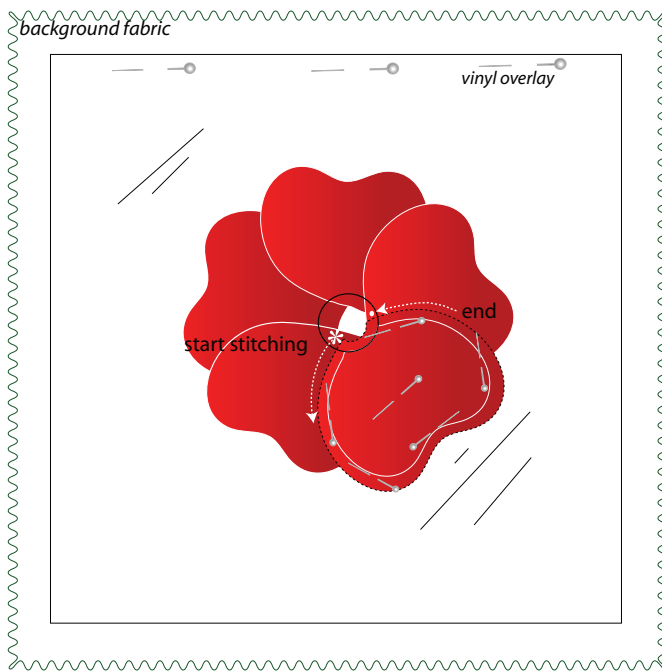
- 1) After marking around template, cut approx. 3/16" seam allowance around the entire template including the area that will fall beneath another piece.



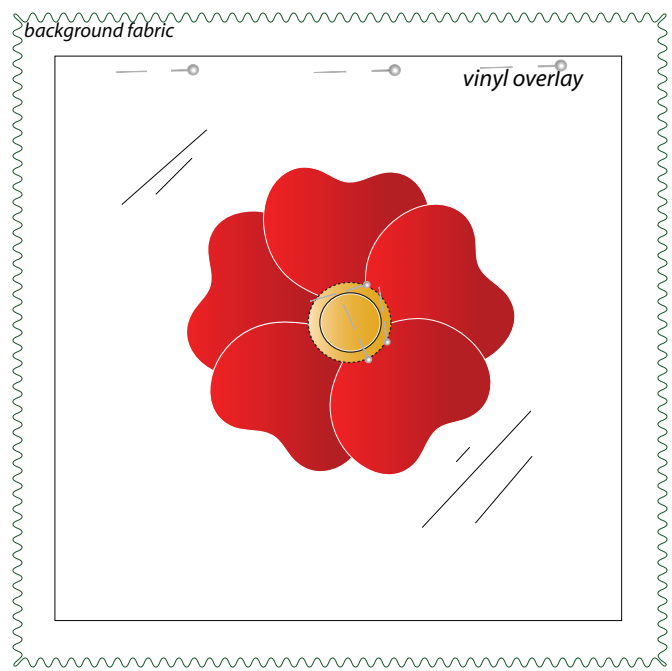
- 2) line up piece under overlay and then pin in place, stitch



- 3) next piece is lined up and ready to sew in place. Continue these steps in the sequence order.



4) The last petal is added and pinned. The only part left unstitched is the part where it will be overlapped by the circle center.



5) Place the last piece (circle center) in place and pin. Stitch around entire piece.
